Now that summer is almost here, we take this opportunity to remind you of covenants and by-laws that help maintain the beauty of Lake Pointe Subdivision and our property values.

May 18, 2009

The following information is from the "Lake Pointe Subdivision Restrictive Covenants and By-Laws" document, which all homeowners should receive at closing. If you do not have a copy, you may download one from the website (go to the "Covenants" tab at the top of the home page) or request one from any Board member.

Landscaping (p. 16, 8.3.C.5)

Two trees with trunks two inches in diameter must be planted in the front yard.

Maintenance free exteriors (p. 16, 8.3.C.3)

All exterior buildings must be constructed with maintenance free material, such as siding or brick.

Limited storage (p. 18, 8.8)

Boats, trailers, campers and vehicles cannot be stored outside. Note: Parking trailers on public streets is against City Code.

Submission of improvement plans (p. 15, 8.3.A & B)

Prior to any improvement on or alterations to a lot, homeowners must submit two sets of plans to the Association Architectural Committee. Common property improvements or alterations that require approval include:

- * swimming pools
- * fences
- * storage sheds
- * patio covers.

Please mail plans to the address on this newsletter. The Committee is required to respond within 30 days.
